### internal adj

### inner adj.

Inner refers to something located further in, or relating to the internal part of something, often implying a deeper, more personal, or less visible aspect.

# Inside or contained within something else:

- Leading off the main hall is a series of small inner rooms.
- The inner workings of the machine are quite complex.

### Inner feelings or thoughts are ones that you do not show or tell other people:

 She struggled with her inner thoughts and emotions.

Inner can describe both physical and metaphorical inward aspects, often emphasizing depth or personal significance. It is often used metaphorically or to describe something that is not immediately visible.

### Interior noun

Interior refers to the inner part or the inside of something, especially when describing the inside of a physical space such as a building, vehicle, or object. It is often used to discuss design, architecture, or the layout of a space.

## the inside part of something:

- The interior of the house was beautifully decorated with modern furniture.
- They spent hours choosing the perfect interior color for their car.
- The building's interior was much larger than it appeared from the outside.

#### the land that is furthest away from the outside or coast of a country or continent:

 Much of Australia's interior is arid.

Internal is more abstract, relating to systems or organizations, while inner often refers to something deeper, personal, or metaphorical, and interior focuses on the inner part of a physical space or object, typically in the context of design or architecture.
