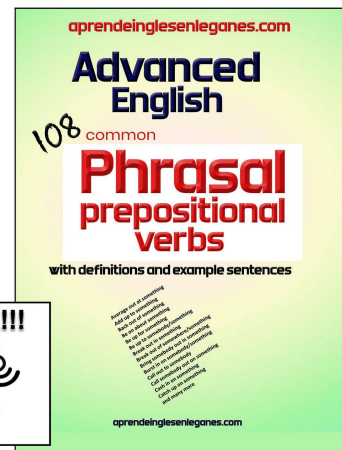

become/serve as/provide a springboard for/to (doing) sth

- The firm's director is confident that the new project will **act as a springboard to** further contracts.
- The document **provided a springboard for** a lot of useful discussion.

a springboard to do something

- They intend to use the £150 million acquisition as a **springboard to** buy other food brands.
